



Besides his wife, Lieutenant McGarry was survived by his parents, Edward and Susan McGarry of Raynham (now deceased) and seven brothers and sisters. Lieutenant James B. McGarry USMC gallantly gave his life for his country and for the peace loving peoples of Viet Nam.

Second Lieutenant McGarry was the recipient of the following medals and awards:

Purple Heart Medal, with white cross distinguishing device, denoting a posthumous award

Combat Action Ribbon, for having taken and returned enemy fire

National Defense Service Medal, for serving on active duty during a time of national conflict

Vietnam Service Medal (yellow), with one bronze star, for participation in one combat phase, Viet Nam Summer-Fall 1969 Campaign (9 June-31 October)

Viet Nam Gallantry Cross Unit Citation, with palm, awarded to the Third Marine Division

Viet Nam Campaign Medal (green), with palm, for either serving 6 months in country or dying in combat

Sharpshooter Badge for the M-14 Rifle

Sharpshooter Badge for the .45 caliber Pistol
