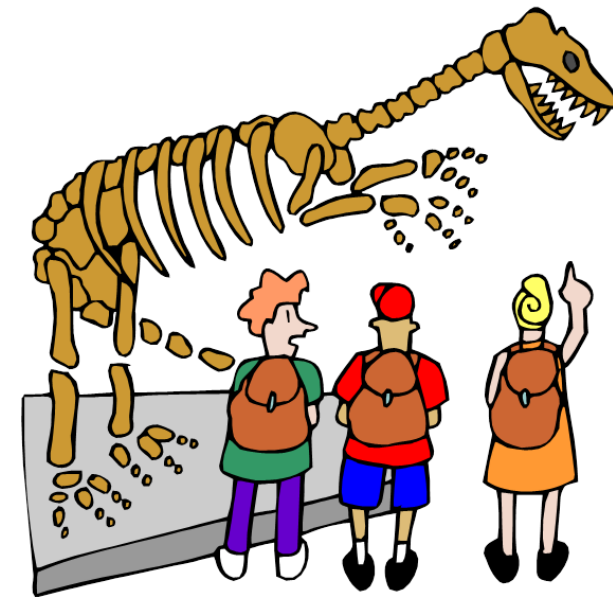

BOOK MUSEUM PASSES

The library offers passes for REDUCED admission to many area museums and zoos.

Reservations are made online at raynhampubliclibrary.org

You'll find passes under Our Services in ABOUT. Click on Passes to Request a Pass.

You'll need your library card and PIN to reserve a pass. Passes are reserved for a specific date. Pass Details provide information on admission fees and pass return policies.

Passes are purchased by the library with funds from the Friends of the Raynham Public Library and the Raynham Cultural Council.

Boston Children's Museum



Explore and discover. Pass available for Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

Buttonwood Park Zoo, New Bedford



Encounter animals from both home and around the world.

Easton Children's Museum



Explore three floors of imaginative exhibits which promote creativity and learning for young children.

Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum



Located in the Fenway of Boston, the museum houses an art collection of world importance.

Massachusetts Parks Pass



Provides unlimited day-use parking at state facilities. Pass must be returned by end of the day.

Museum of Fine Arts, Boston



One of the most comprehensive art museums in the world. Pass funded by the Raynham Cultural Council.

Museum of Science, Boston



More than 500 natural history and scientific exhibits, a planetarium and IMAX theater.

New England Aquarium, Boston



Watch aquatic life in the four-story giant ocean tank; discover, explore, learn about marine life.

New Bedford Whaling Museum



Through artifacts, ship models and fine art, the museum tells the history of the whaling industry.

Tower Hill Botanic Garden, Boylston



A four-season display of ornamental, edible and native plants on 171 acres with walking trails.
